Verse:

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION:

Good news, good news! Alleluia! Today our Savior is born.

GOSPEL: Luke 2:1-20

This is a reading from the Gospel of Luke.

When Caesar Augustus, the ruler of Rome, passed a law that everyone in the world should be enrolled, all the people went to be registered in the towns where they were born.



Joseph and Mary went from the town of Nazareth to the City of David, which is called Bethlehem, because Joseph was born in the family of David. While they were there, the time came for Mary's child to be born, and she gave birth to her first-born son. She wrapped him in swaddling clothes and laid him in a manger because there was no room for them in the inn.

At that time, there were shepherds in the fields watching over their sheep during the night.
An angel of God appeared to them, and the glory of God surrounded them with a great light. And they were frightened. The angel said to them,

"Do not be afraid. I have come to bring you good news, news of great joy, to be shared by all the people. Today, in the City of Bethlehem, a Savior has been born for you, Christ the Lord! And this will be a sign for you: You will find a child wrapped in swaddling clothes and lying in a manger."
