World Refugee Day 2022 Annual Special Collection for the St Joe's Refugee Outreach Committee (ROC) during the June 18th and 19th weekend liturgies.

"Everyone has the right to seek safety- whoever they are, wherever they come from,

and whenever they are forced to flee." All are encouraged to read and reflect on the single page article at UNHCR - World Refugee Day 2022 - Messaging.

We are grateful to parishioners for last year's collection which raised \$4,470 and allowed the ROC to provide a large range of services, from dental care to translation fees, to help those in refugee situations, settle and integrate into Ottawa life. The proceeds from this year's collection will allow the ROC to continue to assist individuals and families in various circumstances and contribute to the costs associated with sponsorships. Presently we are working on sponsorships for a mother of senior age and her adult daughter who have lived for several years as refugees in the Middle East. The ROC has raised \$12,000.00, towards the total sponsorship cost of \$33,000, which will cover start-up costs and monthly living expenses for the first year of settlement. With your help we can raise the remaining \$21,000 by the end of July.
