NOTICE: Maintenance at St. Joe's this coming week

Reconstruction of rectory parking lot entrance steps: The wooden steps and landing leading up to the rectory parking lot door are near the end of their lifespan. We have hired a contractor to replace this structure and the work is anticipated to begin on or around October 15. The renovation will take approximately one week. During this time, please note that parishioners and volunteers will not have access to this entrance. Please use 151 Laurier Ave E door during regular business hours or coordinate with your staff contact or ministry lead for alternative access.

Hanging lights in the church: From Wednesday through Friday of next week (October 15-17), we will be having maintenance and conversion to LED lights in our church. LED lights are long lasting and are known to use approximately 90% less energy than incandescent bulbs – and the lift that will be used will be fully electric, eliminating gas fumes in the church. Both of these components of the work advance our commitment of prioritising sustainability and being environmentally conscious wherever we can.

Due to the aforementioned church maintenance this coming week. the noon Weekday Masses on October 15, 16, and 17 will take place in the Chapel located in the rectory.

access the Chapel via the Church, following signage. As overhead work is happening in the Church, this will not be possible. We instead ask that you please access the Chapel via our office entrance at 151 Laurier Avenue East. However, this entry point has stairs. If you have trouble with stairs, please contact the front office via phone when you arrive and Mikayla will be pleased to meet you at the Wilbrod ramped entrance, escorting you through the construction. We will do the reverse when you leave from Mass.

Our church is normally open to the public for private prayer each Tuesday to Thursday from 9am-1pm. On October 15 and 16, the church will be closed during these times; again due to the overhead maintenance work.

Canada Post Strikes and the Impact on St. Joe's

The Canadian Union of Postal Workers initiated a total strike starting September 25, and will change to a rotating strike following Thanksgiving.

Thankfully, a mail strike has minimal disruption on St. Joe's – in comparison to other charities, we receive minimal donations through lettermail, thanks to our main donation method of the collection plate as well as recurring donations through **online platforms** and Autodebit. We do have limited option for some payments, however, that must be paid by cheque. These have been arranged to be picked up or hand delivered to the payee, or couriered when neither is possible.

We will continue to monitor the status of lettermail, extending these alternate measures if needed.
