

SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



FIRST READING: *Isaiah 62:1-5*

A reading from the prophet Isaiah.

The prophet Isaiah said,

“Because I love you Jerusalem,
I will not be silent.
I will not rest
until you shine like a burning torch
and everyone sees your salvation.
All nations will know that you have been saved,
and all the kings of the world will see your glory.
God will give you a new name, a special name,
and will hold you like a precious crown.
Just as a bridegroom is happy
and rejoices with his bride,
so God will be happy
and rejoice because of you.”

RESPONSE: *Psalm 96*

All the nations will praise you, and know that you are God.

Verses:

1. Give God glory. Give honor and praise.
2. Proclaim salvation day after day.
3. Tell the nations God's wonderful deeds.

(Repeat Response after each Verse.)

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION:

1. Mary said: “Do what he says. Do whatever Jesus tells you.”
2. Alleluia! Mary said: “Do whatever Jesus tells you.”



GOSPEL: *John 2:1-11*

A reading from the Gospel of John.

One day there was a wedding at Cana in Galilee,
and Mary the mother of Jesus was there.
Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the wedding.
Now when Jesus' mother
saw that there wasn't any wine left, she said to him,

"They don't have any more wine."

Jesus said,

"Why are you telling me about this?

It is not time for people to know who I am."

Then Jesus' mother said to those
who were serving at the celebration,

"Do whatever Jesus tells you."

Now there were six large water jugs there,
and each of them held about twenty or thirty gallons.
Jesus said to the servers,

"Fill those jugs with water."

After the servers filled the jugs, Jesus said,

"Now take some of it to the waiter in charge of the celebration."

The waiter did not see what happened,
so when he tasted the water which Jesus had turned into wine,
he called the bridegroom over and said to him,

"People usually serve the very best wine first.

Then after the guests have been drinking for a long time,
they serve the cheaper wine.

But you have saved the best wine until now!"

And so, the first miracle that Jesus did was at Cana in Galilee.
With this sign, Jesus revealed his glory,
and his disciples believed in him.
