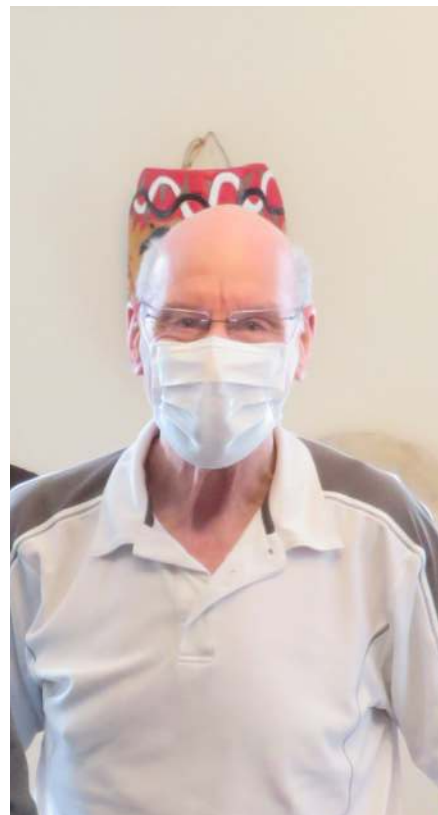

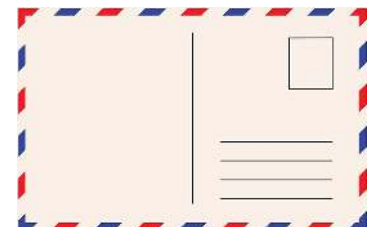

EVENTS AT LOCAL CHURCHES DURING THE POPE'S VISIT, A 1-PAGE PRAYER RITUAL, AND MORE
