Fundraising Campaign in Support of Indigenous Reconciliation



The Catholic bishops of Canada have established a registered charity to support and advance healing and reconciliation initiatives with indigenous peoples. The charity is expected to manage the Indigenous Reconciliation Fund, which will accept contributions from 73 dioceses across Canada in order to fulfill the \$30 million financial commitment made by Canada's Bishops in September 2021. Our Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall pledge to

support this fund is \$1.2 million.

St Joe's will participate in the Archdiocesan effort, and we plan to raise \$5,000. Initially, the Archdiocesan campaign was to begin this weekend. However, the materials are not yet ready. Kimberly Walsh, fundraising coordinator of the Archdiocese, said in a phone conversation on Sept 28th that the campaign would launch on Thanksgiving weekend.
