
Something for Everyone!

A Christ-Centred, Co-Journey Towards Healing

One of the ways that we can show our appreciation for the blessings in our life is by sharing with others. We are asking you to consider supporting the Indigenous Reconciliation Fund set up by the Bishops of Canada. **On November 5th and 6th, the Archdiocese will hold a special collection.** All monies raised will be used to support initiatives by local Indigenous groups and organizations. An example would be a project to create oral histories as told by Indigenous elders.

Pick up your St. Kateri prayer card at church this weekend!

Saint Kateri, known as “the Lily of the Mohawks”, was born in 1656 in what is now New York State. Persecuted for the Catholic faith she held so tenaciously, she moved to a Christian Mohawk village in what is now Kahnawake, within the current diocese of Saint-Jean Longueuil, where she died at the age of 24.

All Canadians, Indigenous and Non-Indigenous, celebrated when Saint Kateri Tekakwitha was canonized by Pope Benedict XVI in Rome on October 21, 2012. In a 1980 address to North American Indigenous Peoples, Pope John Paul II, as he then was, had this to say about Saint Kateri:

“We are all edified by her complete trust in the providence of God, and we are encouraged by her joyful fidelity to the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.”


