Bishops of Canada Deepen Their Commitments to Walk Together with Indigenous People on the Healing and Reconciliation Journey

\$30 MILLION

Grants from the Indigenous Reconciliation Fund are in support of local projects and initiatives for:

- ▶ Healing and reconciliation for communities and families.
- ▶ Culture and language revitalization.
- ▶ Education and community building.
- ▶ Dialogues involving Indigenous elders, spiritual leaders and youth with a focus on Indigenous spirituality and culture.

The Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall has committed to raising \$1.2 million as its contribution to this Fund.

\$1.2 MILLION

The type of projects that may be funded include:

- ▶ Programs that offer training and leadership formation to Indigenous communities led by Kateri Native Ministry.
- ▶ Curricula for school-aged children that involve using stories to teach language and share their Indigenous culture.
- ▶ Curation of oral histories.
- ▶ Support the organization of a powwow, a celebration of Indigenous culture in which people from diverse Indigenous nations gather for the purpose of dancing, singing, and honouring the traditions of their ancestors.
