Construction set to begin at 174 Wilbrod entrance!

Construction for our new front steps and a new accessibility ramp at the 174 Wilbrod entrance will begin the week of November 7th. The main entrance will no longer be available for public access. As such, please use the parking lot door to enter the church.



We are working on ensuring that a temporary accessibility ramp is also in place. At this time, a ramp is to be placed on the Cumberland Street side at the start of the project, using the entrance between the church and sacristy.

The Engineers are to reassess for Winter conditions and modifications to be announced.

We expect the main entrance of the church to be re-opened on 23 December 2022.
