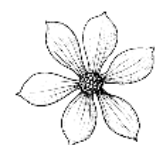

Pastoral Care Basic Course Starting September 18, 2023

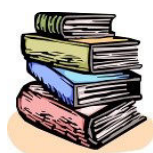
The Ottawa Pastoral Care Training Program's Basic Course in pastoral care begins September 18th, 2023. Registration is open for both in-person and Zoom-based courses. In-person classes are hosted at St. Paul's Presbyterian Church (971 Woodroffe Ave). The program includes 10 sessions; students who complete these are issued a Certificate in Pastoral Care. Registration fee: \$125. Please register no later than September 6th. Space is limited and these courses do fill up. The Ottawa Pastoral Care Training Program (OPCTP) has been providing courses and workshops in Ottawa and surrounding communities since 1979. The OPCTP is recognized as an interdenominational entity under the general sponsorship of the Christian Council of the Capital Area (CCCA).
