Step-Up Special Offerings: Monthly Update for September 2023

September 2023: \$1,030 || Year-to-Date Total: \$15,228

On September 30th and October 1st, 2023, our church's front entrance reopened to the community following a long, nine-month construction project. We celebrated with a blessing and group photos after the Saturday evening and Sunday morning Masses. This major capital project cost over \$300,000 and we were able to pay for it by using parish reserves – funds accumulated over the years. In the coming months and years, we will have to ensure that these reserves are replenished, in order to meet upcoming capital needs.

Music Ministry Information

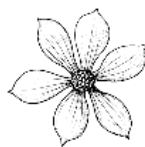
