Sunday Mass Time Change for Advent & Christmas Season

From Sunday, December 3rd 2023 through Sunday, January 7th 2024, we will celebrate one Mass each Sunday morning at 10:30 AM!

This joining of the 9:30 AM and 11:30 AM Sunday morning Masses for Advent and Christmas represents a trial period. The initiative arises from discussions and collaboration in both Liturgy Committee and Parish Pastoral Council on how to provide our parish with more opportunities to gather as a community around our liturgies and how to ensure that our celebrations remain dynamic and life-giving to all present. Celebrating Mass together at 10:30 AM is an opportunity for parishioners traditionally attending 9:30 AM and 11:30 AM liturgies to get to know each other better, to create new connections and build friendships. We all share in the faith and values that define St. Joe's. We will be sure to include time for our community to gather and socialize on these special Sundays. On Gaudete Sunday, after several weeks of these shared liturgies, we will seek feedback from as many parishioners as possible on their experience of these joint liturgies.
