FLOOD UPDATE

Remediation continues at the parish. The situation is currently stable, as no further water damage has been inflicted since the second flood. While the Chapel and rectory washroom remain closed due to repair work, the Supper Table remains in operations and the Women's Centre has just announced temporary service hours effective Monday, July 8th.

We appreciate, in advance, your patience regarding temporary changes to facility hours and use as we remain open. So many of our services and ministries assist the broader community and we are working hard to ensure our activities persist despite the state of the building. Immigration, Refugee and Citizenship Canada requires that we have a minimum of \$30,000 for Mohammad & Heba's family's first year of settlement.

Funds donated by the end of this December 2024 or pledged by December 2024 to be collected in 2025 will be **matched, to a limit of \$10,000**, thanks to past generous donations to the ROC. Tax receipts can also be issued. We are very grateful for the recent donations received, and we are well on our way to achieving our goal.
